Monday 8th June	Discuss new rules that will keep everyone safe in the school, shops, parks and other spaces (keep it relevant to your child). What may you see when out and about? e.g. people trying to keep 2 m apart, wearing masks/gloves, hand washing/disinfecting rules, etc. How does it make you feel? What can you do to help?	Add a little of washing up liquid to the water, use sticks and string/pipe cleaners to create bubble wands. Count how many bubbles can you make/pop?	Learn a new song that will help you with remembering how to wash hands. Do you like this one? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=L89nN03pBzI&vI=en
Tuesday 9th June	Use a paintbrush dipped in water to mark make/write/draw with water. An adult can say the sounds and children have to write the correct grapheme/s in response. You can also do it with tricky words.	Can you write numbers up to 20 on the post-it notes then ask your grown up to hide it inside or in your garden? When you find the number you have to jump/hop/skip this many times. How many numbers have you managed to find?	Use hoop or sticks as a frame, chalk inside it to draw a picture or use natural materials to create ocean-themed transient art.
Wednesday 10th June	Listen to "Commotion in the Ocean". https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9pRhqZ8Jffs What is your favourite Ocean creature and why? Can you draw a picture of that creature and label it e.g. gills, fins, teeth, etc.	Learn this simple counting song "In the big blue sea" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=_jxzZMw89qY Get a bowl/hoop and pretend it's the sea ask your grown up to place a different number of things in the sea (bowl), count them and carry on singing the song.	Make fabulous Ocean inspired hat/crown using available resources.
Thursday 11th June	Make playdough and/or junk modelling sea creature e.g. jellyfish, octopus. How many tentacles for the octopus? Can you write a sentence to describe your ocean creature?
