Shuffle a pack of 1-20 cards. Take 2 cards and show children. Can they write the smaller number? Repeat.</p>	<p>Construct a beanstalk. You will need to stick kitchen roll tubes together, paint them green or cover with green paper and secure in place using masking or sellotape. Then draw, cut out and hole punch leaves, next thread them onto a green string/wool/pipe cleaner and secure to the beanstalk stem (tubes). Place a paper plate covered with cotton wool on the top of the beanstalk and secure with the tape.</p>
