You will need to provide counters (or buttons) and a partner for them to play with.</p>	<p><b>GEOGRAPHY</b> <b>What are some of Europe's most important human characteristics?</b> In this lesson, you will learn about the population of Europe as well as understanding the population density in each subregion of Europe. You will study the important cities and landmarks across Europe, learning lots of new facts! Finally, you will also learn more about the economy of Europe and what is traded into (imported) and traded out of (exported) Europe. How short did you get the question interval?</p>	<p><b>ART &amp; DESIGN - Sewing a mobile phone cover</b> Michelle Ackerley gives instructions on choosing matching fabric colours and thread and what materials are needed to have a go at using invisible stitching to make a mobile phone cover. She demonstrates how to use feature stitching around the outside of the case to finish off the creation. Click <a href="#">here</a> for the video. This clip introduces some simple basic techniques: Measuring, matching thread and material colour, the use of contrasting colours for design impact and basic stitching. Children could consider how they would use these techniques within their own alternative design project.</p>
