Dear Parents and Carers

Following the announcement that all children should return to school from the 8th March I wish to remind you of some of the procedure in place.

We are delighted to have the children return to us and can't wait to have them back!

Arrangements will be the same as they were in September, so staggered starts and ends of the day, staggered break and lunchtimes and separate class bubbles as before.

Currently we are still not allowed to have parents or visitors on site, and masks will need to be worn as you enter the school premises.

Year 3/4/5/6 will start school at 8.45am and finish at 3.15pm

Reception Year 1 /2 will start at 9.00am and finish at 3.00pm

Please remember to use the one way system in operation.

All children are expected to be in school, so please remember to 'phone the school if they are off for any reason.

PE kit will continue as before, so children wear PE kit to school on those days. (Please make sure it is appropriate for the weather)

We all still need to be Covid aware. So please follow the national guidance, which includes social distancing, minimising social contact, regular hand washing and checking your children for symptoms. Any children who display symptoms will be sent home, and will need to take a test.

All staff in school take two Lateral Flow tests a week to ensure that we are not spreading the virus without knowing we are ill. It is up to us all to ensure that by following the rules we can help speed up the process of lockdown being relaxed bit by bit.

For those of you teaching your children at home, well done, and good luck with your last week, the end is very close now. You have done a fabulous job!
